BE CAREFUL WHERE YOU CLICK

- Use websites you know and trust
- Look for the security padlock icon at the top left corner of a page BEFORE you provide personal or financial information
- If an online offer or deal sounds too good to be true, then it probably is too good to be true: don't trust it

KEEP PINS & PASSWORDS PRIVATE

- Create strong passwords

- NEVER write your passwords down
